SNOW CLEARING PARKING BANS

Traffic Bylaw No. 1 of 2013

BYLAW RESPONSIBILITIES

Parked vehicles get in the way of snow clearing operations and cause large piles of snow to be left on newly cleared streets. This can be a cause of frustration for your neighbours and other motorists.

IF YOU PARK IN AN AREA SIGNED "NO-PARKING" YOU RISK A FINE AND TOWING CHARGES.

Fines: \$100 (\$50 if paid early)

Towing: Towing Fee + Daily Impound Fee

SNOW ROUTE PARKING BANS



Priority 1 snow routes are subject to parking bans in the winter when there is a major snow event.

Vehicles **must be** removed from roadways marked with "Snow Route when Declared "signs immediately when

a ban has been declared. Vehicle owners are responsible for knowing when a ban is in effect.

TEMPORARY PARKING BANS

All other streets in Prince Albert (priority 2,3,4) are signed at least 12 hours before crews arrive to clear snow. All parked vehicles must be removed 12 hours after the signs have been put up.

FINES AND TOWING

If you suspect your vehicle has been towed, please call (306) 953-4330 to inquire. When towed, Bylaw Enforcement will contact vehicle owners by registered mail to notify them.
